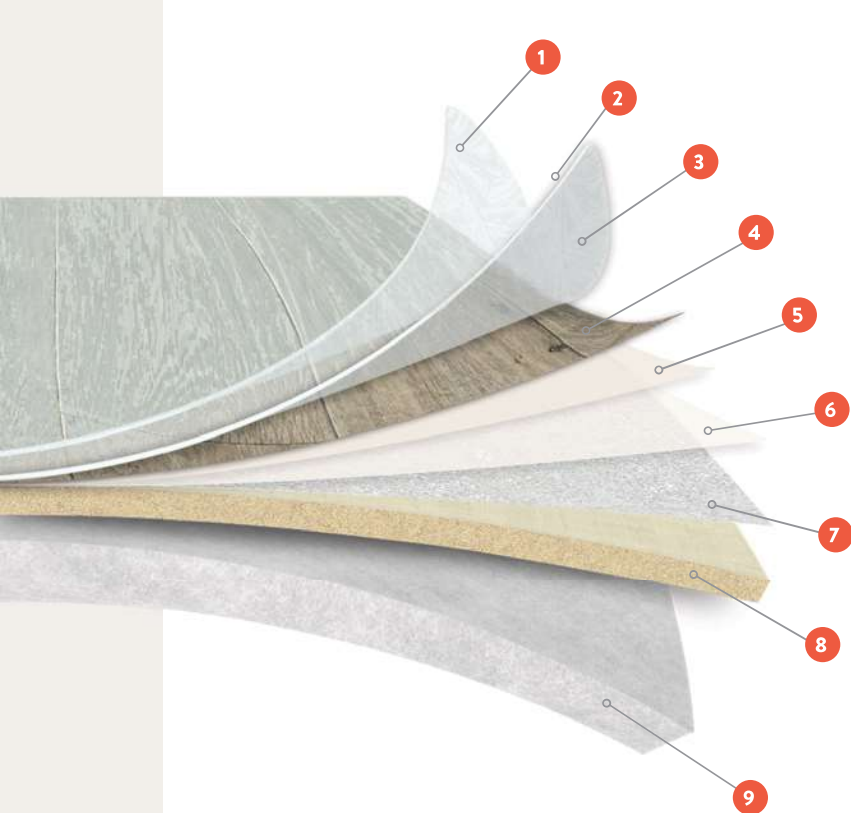


Cleaning's a breeze

Layers

PU lacquer: protection from scratches, stains and dirt

An extra polyurethane (PU) protective layer improves scratch and stain resistance. Fighting off the spills and accidents of family life and completely pet-proof, it enhances the everyday performance and makes the floor a breeze to clean.

Structured emboss: a natural look with excellent grip

An embossing roller applies a natural wood or stone structure to the hardwearing surface for a more natural appearance. The structured emboss also gives textile backed sheet vinyl better slip-resistance, making it perfect for barefoot or busy areas.

Wear layer: durability for a lasting family floor

Made in-house for the best in reliability and quality, the PVC wear layer makes sure the floor is ready to last.

Pattern: contemporary natural design

This layer is where we bring contemporary natural designs to life. The process is in-house from start to finish for original designs that are printed with eco-friendly inks. We use multiple cylinders for a more detailed and refined design.

Print layer: for sharper design

This second PVC layer is applied to smooth out the stabilising glass fibre beneath and to provide a finish that's perfect for creating high-quality designs with high definition.

Impregnation layer: enhanced

Permeating through the glass fibre in a process that's similar to reinforced concrete, the impregnation layer adds dimensional stability.

Glass fibre: strength and stability

Glass fibre brings strength and stability to the construction, giving the advantage that you don't need expansion gaps. Preventing contraction, expansion, cracking and curling, it ensures the floor stays where it should. Important when it comes to rapid temperature changes such as those experienced in holiday homes or recreational vehicles.

PVC backing: versatility in performance

This waterproof PVC backing layer is available in different specifications so we can tweak the performance of the floor: super-strong compactback, powerback for impact resistance or thermoback for better thermal insulation.

Textile backing: easier installation and more comfort

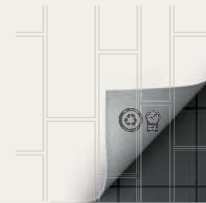

Used in most of our collections, our Comfort White textile backing is giving the vinyl floor a great value and performance thanks to its medium density and its strong fibers.

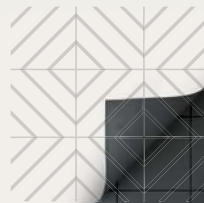


NEW: 100% recycled, made with Social Plastic®

Installation

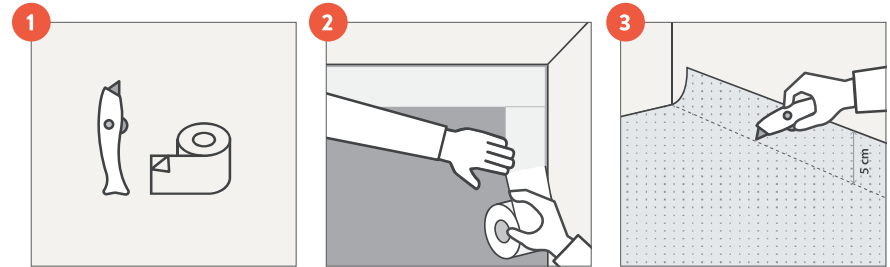


One of the great advantages of our textile backed sheet vinyl is that you can install it with even greater ease than our standard sheet vinyl, saving you lots of time and costs.

The textile layer:

- ✓ Will even out irregularities in the subfloor, saving you time and costs in subfloor preparations.
- ✓ Has an even better stability, therefore you don't need those eyesoring expansion gaps.
- ✓ Has a better grip on the subfloor, which makes it possible to semi-loose lay your vinyl floor on an even bigger surface, up to 40m².

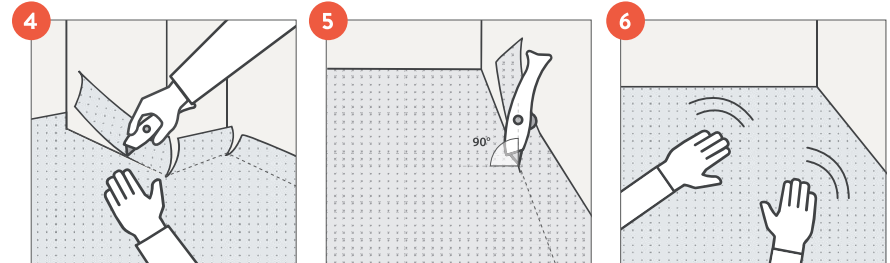
In this visual installation guide we are showing the semi-loose lay installation, which is the most common and DIY-friendly installation method for textile backed sheet vinyl:



1 A simple utility knife and Xtrafloor Velcro Tape or regular double-sided tape is all you need.

2 Apply Xtrafloor Velcro Tape or appropriate double sided tape to the perimeter of the area. Xtrafloor Velcro Tape has the advantage of easy repositioning of the vinyl sheet, double side tape is almost impossible to reposition. If using double sided tape, leave the protective foil in position for the time being (install one wall at a time).

3 Line up the cut sheet to your selected starting wall. The material is laid with the 5 cm over-cut running up the walls, ensuring that the pattern runs parallel to the wall.



4 Push the flooring into the joint between the wall and floor with a straight edge and neatly cut off excess material around the edges of the room in small strips at a time, gradually working the material down to the floor keeping the blade tight against the skirting board.

5 Always hold the knife perpendicular to the floor to keep a straight cut finish. Ensure the product is free of tension (there may be 1mm of give).

6 Avoid bubbles, compressions and tensions. To remove any bubbles, rubbing from the inside out should even out the floor.
